These are the first key stage 2 attainment statistics since 2019, after assessments were cancelled in 2020 and 2021.

The overall statistics cover all year groups who have experienced disruption to their learning during the pandemic.

It cannot be underestimated the impact the pandemic has had on the development of pupils, particularly in KS1 – nevertheless the school is determined to ensure that the provision when looking forward supports both attainment and progress as our pupils continue their Herrick Journey.

In this report you will identify how as a school we use statistical data in self-evaluation and planning for improved outcomes for pupils. Our evaluative process leads to important benchmarking questions: Firstly, how does Herrick's performance compare to our own 2019 outcomes?

When available, compare national and LA averages? Do we have any underperforming groups? What does overall progress tell us about achievement? What are the strengths and areas of development? This in effect informs our understanding of areas for improvement and ultimately the formulation of actions needed to raise standards.

Attainment	Overall outcome above national (+10%), reading age average progress is 2 years. Scaled score (105 in-line with national expectation.
PA (H/M/L)	At higher level (GD) 33% represented mostly by 'H', limited numbers of 'M' achieving higher level. 50% of 'L' achieve expected, inclusive of SEN (3 pupils).
Boys v Girls	Girls 10% above boys at expected, but similar % at higher standard. However, both reading age and average progress of boys is more than girls – 13/11 and 4 months respectively.
PP	100% of PP achieved expected and 10% below non-PP at higher standard. Previous summer teacher assessment identified 50% at expected – good attainment based on year 5 outcomes.
SEN	69% achieved expected and 8% higher standard.
2019	In comparison to 2019, 12% increase at expected and a 10% increase at higher standard.

Attainment	Overall outcome above national (+9%), nevertheless disappointing to outcomes pre-pandemic which averaged at 90%. Higher standard also fell approximately 20% below school outcomes. Decline in writing at both expected and higher standard.
PA (H/M/L)	100% 'H' achieved expected, although less than 50% achieved higher standard, compared to previous summer where 57% identified as higher. 'M' and 'L' bands achieved 88% and 30% respectively at expected but no higher standard. Moderation has supported assessment of writing – LA representative worked with English lead to review pupil work.

Year 4 Multiplication Test

Main Findings:

Of the 54 children that participated in the MTC, 39 of them scored 16 or more; with 21 of them scoring 21-25. Of the 21, 9 children scored 24 and 2 children scored full marks.

Of our highest attaining children (21-25 marks) 13 of them were girls and 8 boys. Of our mid-attaining band (16-20), 7 were girls and 11 were boys. Of the low attaining band, there was an even split (5 boys and 5 girls). Of the children causing concern (0-10), 3 were girls and 2 were boys. Of these 5, 3 are on the SEND register.

Of the 6 PP children in Y4, 5 of them are deemed mid or high attaining children in relation to the MTC outcomes. (Herrick assessment guidelines). 3 of them are girls, with one of them being a HA child.

Strengths:
